



Introduction to the colorectal and anal cancer multidisciplinary team (MDT)

Information for patients, relatives and carers

This leaflet provides information about the multidisciplinary team (MDT) involved in your care at the Royal Berkshire Hospital. There are also some useful telephone numbers and website addresses that you may find helpful.

The multi-disciplinary team

It is the policy of the MDT that all patients (irrespective of age and stage of the disease) with a new diagnosis of colorectal or anal cancerwill be discussed at the multi-disciplinary team meeting (MDTM) at the earliest opportunity. At this meeting, the team will discuss individual treatment plans and follow-up arrangements to ensure that every patient with cancer receives the best possible care. These meetings will also be an opportunity to discuss difficult cases at any stage duringtreatment if necessary. The meetings take place weekly.

Who are the colorectal cancer MDT?

- **Designated lead clinician (chair)**, who will take overall responsibilityfor the service.
- Designated surgeon(s).
- **Oncologist**, with expertise inradiotherapy and chemotherapy.
- Radiologist, with expertise in looking at tumour sites on an x-ray.
- **Histopathologist**, with expertise in looking at the cells of tumour sites from biopsies.
- Clinical nurse specialist (key worker), will provide information and support for patients.
- **Stoma nurse**, will provide stoma information and support for patients.
- MDT co-ordinator.
- Users issues and patient information lead.

- Trials nurse, will provide information to the team on any new trials.
- Cancer support worker, will provide information and support.
