The Royal Berkshire Hospital's Audiology hearing aid repair services have undergone some recent changes. These aim to streamline services and improve efficiency, resulting in reduced waiting times when patients visit. This service is for patients with hearing aids provided by the RBH Audiology service (including those fitted at Henley, Wokingham, Bracknell, Thatcham, Wallingford, and our Mobile Unit).

Why has my hearing aid stopped working?

It is important that you look after your hearing aids by performing regular cleaning and maintenance. Failure to carry out these basic tasks can result in reduced output of sound, feedback (whistling) and can cause a hearing aid to stop working.

You should have been given a "Your Hearing Aid" booklet at your fitting appointment. This contains step-by-step troubleshooting advice.

Following this advice will ensure that you are able to resolve most common

faults that occur with hearing aids.
