# How to access your local Parkinson's Nurse Service

Information for patients in Berkshire West

This leaflet explains how to access your local Parkinson's nurse specialist (CNS) in the Berkshire West area as well as providing other useful local contacts.

### Hello

You have been diagnosed with Parkinson's and have been referred to the Clinical Nurse Specialist (CNS) Team. The CNSs work closely with your consultant and are your point of contact for any support you may need. A named nurse will be allocated to you, according to where you live. We will also send you a 'Newly Diagnosed Pack", this provides general information about Parkinson's, including advice on driving.

Please contact your CNS in between appointment times if you need questions about your condition answered or on-going support.

You can also contact your local Parkinson's group for advice and support. Local advisers from Parkinson's UK (PUK) may also be able to help in your specific area too.
